Paperwork instructions for Mexico missions trips

The forms can be confusing, so I hope you find these instructions helpful. Everyone will fill out 2 forms: 1. <u>Trip Insurance Form</u> 2. <u>U-Reach Assumption of Risk form.</u>

TRIP INSURANCE FORM

- Adults fill out one form the file is named "Adult Trip Insurance". (5 pages)
 - Anyone can sign as your witness. They don't have to attend the trip.
 - Please scan <u>all 5 pages</u> of the document and save as follows: last name, first name, trip insurance. Then email the file to me.
- Minors fill out one form the file is named "Minor Trip Insurance". (7 pages)
 - If parent(s) <u>are</u> attending with the child, disregard the top section of page 7 that talks about "Temporary Guardian". Both parents need to sign page 7. You do NOT need a notary.
 - If the parent(s) <u>are not</u> coming on the trip, another trip participant over the age of 25 needs to be identified as the "Temporary Guardian". <u>All three signatures</u> <u>need to be notarized</u> (both parents and temporary guardian)
 - Please scan <u>all 7 pages</u> of the document and save as follows: last name, first name, trip insurance. Then email the file to me.

U-REACH ASSUMPTION OF RISK FORM

- Every participant needs to sign 1 of these forms.
- Any minor traveling <u>without</u> a parent needs to have <u>one</u> parent notarize the form.
